Visa Type	
Visa Requirements	Foreign students wishing to study in Korea must obtain a Student Visa (D-2) from the nearest Korean Embassy or Consulate. All foreign nationals planning to stay in Korea for more than 90 days are required to register at a local Immigration Office and obtain an Alien Registration Card (ARC)

Insurance

Health Insurance is mandatory for all international students. Therefore, all students are required to purchase a designated private health insurance upon arrival at Inha University.

After completing ARC registration, all foreigners will be enrolled in the National Health Insurance (NHIS)

※ Even if you already have health insurance at your home university, you must purchase a designated private health insurance at Inha university according to government regulations.

Off-Campus Housing Fees (as of Fall 2026):
Approximately USD 550–600 per month

- ※ A penalty of KRW 100,000 will be imposed for cancellations made within 30 days prior to the check-in date.
- ※ The International Center provides assistance for students who wish to stay in studio-type (one-room) accommodations near campus.
- ※ The International Center cannot assist with off-campus housing options other than those mentioned above. Students who wish to find shared apartments must do so independently, preferably upon early arrival.
- ※ Off-campus housing fees are subject to change each semester.

Personal illness and medicines	<p>Students are responsible for managing their own health and personal illnesses. If students plan to bring medications from their home country to Korea, they must check in advance whether the medications are permitted by the Korean Ministry of Food and Drug Safety (MFDS) (https://www.mfds.go.kr/eng/index.do).</p> <p>If required, students must complete the necessary procedures to obtain prior approval for carrying such medications in accordance with MFDS regulations.</p>
